Ishaq Mir from GDC Kilhotran. Besides all other participants who secured above 70% were also awarded with appreciation E-Certificates.



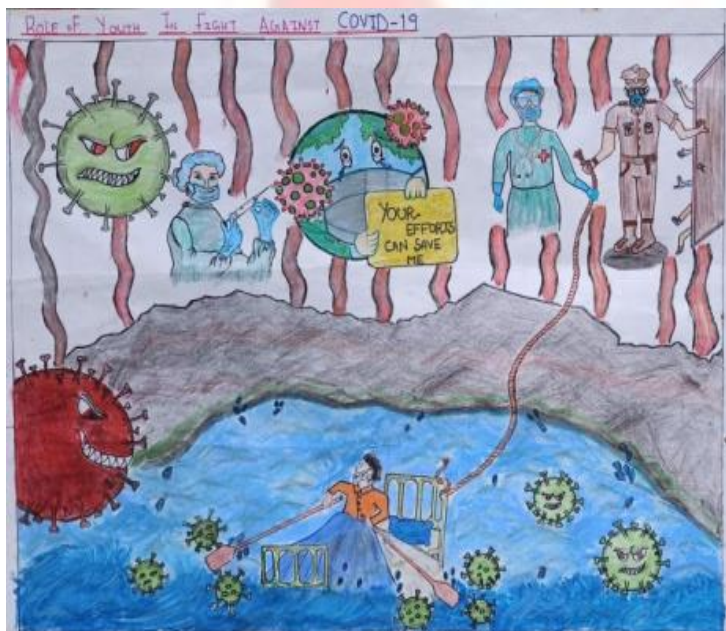
